General Goals:

- Achieve an effective, accessible, and equitable national health system
- Offer a better response to the needs of the population, especially in terms of mother and child healthcare, including acceptable and sustainable vaccination

Specific Objectives:

- Strengthen the provision of quality health services to the entire population
- Improve human resources management of the health sector
- Increase the mobilization and allocation of finance resources
- Stimulate demand and use of the health services
- Strengthen and institutionalize a monitoring and evaluation system

TARGETS AND PROGRESS

Partnership Targets

- Train healthcare workers on the benefits and use of data for planning and decision-making

Progress against Targets

The programme will formally begin in 2008. However, the expected results are:

- Improved immunization coverage



- Asses the performance of health data transfer from the primary health centers to the central system
- Carry out regular follow-up and supervisory reviews of the primary health centers
- Strengthen the application of the Equity Funds system implementation plan in the targeted healthcare facilities
- Introduce different strategies for increasing the population’s financial accessibility to healthcare services
- Carry out financial auditing and supervision of the priority healthcare activities in the targeted areas and develop corrective strategies for improving the programme management
- Offer training on financial and programme management to the managers on the periphery of the targeted districts
- Contract healthcare workers
- Support coaching in the targeted areas (supervision, guidance, mentoring)
- Identify the factors that limit the use of the services by the population
- Develop and institutionalize community healthcare strategies
- Increased offering of healthcare services
- Increased use of these services in the targeted areas
