



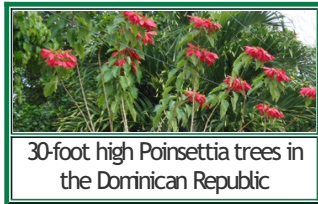

**Expanding PPAF's Work on Clean Cooking in Haiti**

PPAF is expanding its work on clean cooking and clean fuel. While continuing to work on ethanol stoves and fuel we are also becoming active in use of biogas and solar cookstoves.

### Please Give Generously to PPAF

PPAF Senior Fellow Tom Setchel will visit Haiti for two weeks in January 2017 to work on upgrading two distilleries that produce ethanol near Port-au-Prince and in Leogane, and will travel with the Haiti representative of Solavore solar cookstoves, Rose Basile, who is also the head of KDCK (Konbit pou Developman Commune Kot-de-Fer}, to construct biodigesters in Cotes de Fer, on the southern coast of Haiti.

We hope you will support the work of the Foundation. We are focusing on several main areas:

- Acting as a voice for clean cooking and women's opportunities;
- Improving the productivity of local distilleries to fuel ethanol stoves;
- Installing bio-digesters to produce biogas for cooking, with KDCK;
- Promoting use of solar stoves, working with Solavore, LLC; and
- Encouraging use of improved charcoal stoves and briquettes from sugarcane bagasse, through D&E Green and CarbonRoots.

If everyone who reads our newsletter gives at least \$10, this will fund a bio-digester and the technical support to set it up in Cotes de Fer, which was badly affected by Hurricane Matthew.
