PPAF Haiti Projects, Priorities and the Peoples Climate March

From the Executive Director:

Dear Friends,

More than a billion people from around the world celebrate Earth Day every year. This year in addition, the Peoples Climate March will send a message to our own government about the importance of reducing global warming.

In PPAF we are celebrating by raising money to help families and promote women's and girls' entrepreneurship in Haiti. We are working with several organizations to expand the use of non-polluting stoves, whether ethanol, biogas or solar. The aim is to reduce reliance on charcoal and wood that cause deforestation and to reduce respiratory disease from smoke and soot from those fuels. Just yesterday we received another request to collaborate with an organization interested in making solar ovens available.

We have received online several hundred dollars toward the stated goal of \$2,500, but are raising the goal to \$5,000 as we have received two very generous checks by mail.

In our last e-newsletter we described recent work including a seminar at the UN Foundation on girls, women, clean energy and entrepreneurship; participation in planning by the Global Alliance for Clean Cookstoves to transform the cookstoves and fuels market in Haiti; connections with the Haiti Adolescent Girls Network; and local connections for biogas cooking and environmental action.

PPAF and our colleagues are working together to improve life in Haiti and to collaborate on issues that are important for health, economic well-being, women & girls, and the environment. Funds will be used toward projects in Cotes de Fer and in Carrefour, Haiti.
