Dear Friends and Colleagues,

Thank you to all who have so far donated to PPAF's Global Giving campaign. Because of you we rank #23 out of 624 in the competition. We have raised \$3,175 from 23 individuals toward our initial goal of \$5,000 within the campaign. Other funds sent by checks and Facebook or pledged to PPAF bring us close to \$5,000 but cannot be counted in the Global Giving Challenge.

We have a new challenge to meet, though, and will get additional funds from the Global Giving organization if we meet it **ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 13 - a BONUS DAY**. Won't you please help?

How can we win a \$1,000 cash prize? The project with the most funds raised and the project with the most unique donors secured on *BonusDay* (December 13) will each win a \$1,000 cash prize.

We need a minimum of 17 more unique donors. Amounts as little as \$10 and as high as \$1,000 count. If you give a recurring monthly donation, you count as TWO donors.

Settings include a network of girls' clubs, several women-owned small-scale businesses, three schools/training centers, an R&D agricultural center and a university. Our project engages local groups, documents innovations, assesses challenges & successes, publicizes results & promotes expansion.
