A gift from you will help PPAF continue to make a difference in energy and clean cookstoves for Haiti, and partnerships in Madagascar and the Dominican Republic. Recent newsletters and blog articles describe our accomplishments and outreach.

We have brought together and worked with business people, investors, government officials, technical experts, educators, non-profits and UN officials. We have made presentations in New York; Washington, DC; Florida; Arizona and Haiti about the destructive relations among poverty, health, energy and environmental degradation in Haiti, with a focus on clean cookstoves as a step toward sustainable development.

Partners are talking and developing business plans to ensure implementation of our Ethanol Cookstove Initiative for Haiti. Bankers and investors are meeting with our partners. We are working to field test the cookstoves with families and street vendors, and have identified a number of Haitian partners and future customers.

Our annual Partners Against Poverty seminar at the UN gave opportunity for owners of renewable energy businesses to present to each other, to Haitian-American professionals and to UN development officials cutting-edge work at the community level.

Stimulus and connections by PPAF led to the provision of over 3,200 hearing aids in Madagascar. Connections made at our 2010 workshop on business and re-development in Southern Haiti have led to the building of 5,000 low-cost houses there.
