The Public-Private Alliance Foundation and several partners are piloting an environmentally friendly ethanol cookstove and a briquette press that uses agricultural waste -- both are environmentally friendly. Partners include SImACT, Inc., Project Gaia International and Dometic AB, plus local organizations including Cap Lamandou Hotel (owned by SimACT), the Art Creation Foundation for Children, and Konbit Pou Ayiti (KonPay), and its partner Social Tap, Inc.
