David Stillman will update the group on piloting cookstove and fuel alternatives in Haiti, focusing on ethanol from sugarcane as a way out of the poverty-disease-deforestation trap of reliance on charcoal for cooking. In 2012 the New York Rotary Foundation provided a grant to the **Public-Private Alliance Foundation** for this. The work is the first of its kind in Haiti, and several important steps have recently been accomplished.

Peace First is a national nonprofit organization that exists to create the next generation of peacemakers. **Ms Alicia Guevara**, Executive Director, New York Branch will explain how children are viewed as natural problem solvers and creative thinkers, and how we can invest in their ability to see themselves as leaders.
