Public-Private Alliance Foundation to hold a
**Consultation on Ethanol Cookstoves and Fuel at
The United Nations**

Thursday, April 4, 9:30 am to 1:00 pm

PPAF, Path to Haiti and other partners are conducting a pilot project toward commercialization of ethanol cookstoves and fuel. It is the first project of its kind in Haiti. The meeting will - (a) advance the expansion of this project through discussions leading to agreements on next steps, and (b) promote the benefits and possibilities of ethanol cookstoves and fuel more widely. The format is plenary and small group sessions. Individualized follow-up is also being arranged. The meeting is by invitation only, with a maximum of 50 participants.
