Update on work at a Guildive in Haiti

As readers know, PPAF is working with a Haitian cookstove manufacturer and with small-scale distillers to develop a low-cost stove and ethanol fuel from sugarcane and reduce families' ruinous reliance on charcoal.

PPAF Senior Fellow Tom Setchel has now returned from a consulting trip to initiate Phase One of the upgrade of the small-scale distillery "Guildive Roche Blanche." He and the owner worked for a week with guildive staff and met several people who could become involved in future.

Phase One covers establishing a monitoring system for weight, moisture content and sugar content of the sugarcane received at the guildive, and actions to improve productivity. The photos below illustrate key elements in the process. Phase Two will deal with fermentation and Phase Three with distillation. Distillery owners provide investment, and the fuel will be marketed, but PPAF is seeking support to help advance the process and provide training.
