NEW SKILLS FOR HAITIAN YOUTH

Most families in Haiti depend on charcoal for daily cooking, leading to respiratory disease and massive deforestation. Low income families have little chance to broaden the horizons for their children. Action to attack these two problems is the main focus of current work by the not-for-profit Public-Private Alliance Foundation and collaborating Haitian and American organizations. Working with a Haitian university center that specializes in biosciences and nursing, the team supports teaching and fieldwork in the first known Haitian college course on solar cooking and biodigesters for biogas and garden fertilizer. Working with a training center for low income children we support baking and sewing classes in a Young Entrepreneurs program. Devoted team members, participants, volunteers and interns combine to create success at low cost to develop innovative options and skills.
